This sketch explores an event which has taken place in the era of the bus pass!

Cast list

4 or 5 elderly people

A bus driver

For this sketch a simple bus stop is needed - it's standing in a space and some elderly people appear and wait in a line, chatting aimlessly. There is a big clock in evidence with hand pointing at 9.27. A pretend bus appears and stops (just a driver in a cap holding a pretend steering wheel). The queue crowds round, all waving bus passes, saying:

Queue: Are we too early, are we too early?

Bus driver: Sorry, it's only twenty seven minutes past nine, I can't let you on and I can't wait, I'm behind schedule already. Do you know what we call you back at the depot?

Queue: No.

Bus driver: We call you the Twirlies, you're always doing this to us.
